Otto Steffeck, 82, Buried at Ladysmith

A former Medford resident, Otto W. Steffeck, 82, died July 2 at St. Joseph's hospital in Marshfield from complications resulting from a fall last February. He had been ill the past five months.

Funeral services were held July 6 at Ladysmith with burial in Riverside cemetery there.

Mr. Steffeck was born May 15, 1882, at Medford. In 1905 he moved to Rib Lake, residing there until 1929 when he moved to Ladysmith. His marriage to Thyra Olson took place at Rib Lake May 17, 1911.

Mr. Steffeck was manager of the Bissell sawmill at Ladysmith and later at Hawkins. Upon the close of the latter, he was employed by the Flambeau Valley Farms Co-op until his retirement six years ago. He was affiliated with the Congregational church and a member of the Masonic lodge.

Surviving are his wife; four sisters, Charlotte, Mrs. Wm. Bog-
lter of Woodruff; Ella, Mrs. Her-
man Peterson of Medford; Meta,
Mrs. Alex Stosick of South Mil-
waukee; and Lillian, Mrs. Jack
Sheperd of Park Falls.

Four brothers, Jack, Emil, Vic-
tor and Chester, and two sisters,
Hilda and Beatrice, preceded him
in death.
