Pfaff Has Log Price List of Twenty-Eight Years Ago Which Lists No. 3 Pine at \$4 per Thousand

Also Shows Lumber Bill of 1902 That Lists Pine Lumber at \$15 a Thousand and Mill Cull Elm at \$4

Bernard Pfaff, farmer of the town of Deer Creek, recently showed us a log price list of twenty-eight years ago. The highest priced logs listed on same were No. 1 pine at \$14 per thousand feet and the lowest were the No. 2 birch logs at \$2 per thousand. No. 1 oak was listed at \$12 and No. 2 at \$5.

He also has a lumber bill of the same winter season, listing No. 2 and better pine lumber at \$15, mill cull elm as low as \$4, and oak at \$15. Under the name of the Pfaff Bros. & Co., Mr. Pfaff and his brother Wenzel operated a lath and shingle mill at Stetsonville.

The log list and the lumber bill were both from the Ellingson Lumber Co., which operated mills at Stetsonville, Dorchester, and Hawkins in those days.

Prices on the lumber bill were: No. 1 and 2 hemlock \$8.50, S Cull
