1. GARAGE BY JOHN HEDBERT'S HOUSE WAS ALLEN KENNEDY BLACKSMITH SHOP.
2. 1900 - GAST OFFICE, COMPANY STORE + COMPANY OFFICE WERE IN A BUILDING DOWN BY THE LAKE. AFTER THIS BUILDING BURNED IN ABOUT 1901, THEY MOVED INTO THE COMMERCIAL HOUSE (SITUATED ABOUT WHERE BILL MARSCHKE HOUSE STANDS) ALONG WITH A BUTCHER SHOP RUN BY NICK WALTON
3. J.J. KENNEDY'S LAKE SHORE HOME WAS DESTROYED BY FIRE IN WINTER OF 1902
3. FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF RIG LAKE - STARTED IN 1901
- FIRST HARDWARE STORE WAS STARTED BY ^{ED GAMOLL} ~~CHARLES ROSEMAN~~ IN 1890. THIS WAS IN THE PREVIOUS ZIELKE STORE (749 McCOMB). HE SOLD OUT TO TAYLOR - TAYLOR MOVED BUSINESS ACROSS THE STREET (740 McCOMB) AND THE VACANT STORE WAS TURNED INTO A DEPT STORE BY PREESE
- MA JODGE'S CAFE WAS ONCE BARBER'S SALOON (1900). HE SOLD TO JOE MARCUS. LATER, HENRY TALBOT OPENED A STORE BUT WENT BROKE. A WOMAN ONCE HAD A CANDY STORE THERE ALSO.
