I'm enclosing a complete copy of the 1926 Rib Lake Sanborn Insurance Company map. The cost is 25 cents per sheet, plus a \$15 service charge. Personal checks or credit card (Visa or MasterCard, account number, date of expiration, name of the card holder exactly as it appears on the card) are accepted means of payment.

You asked if A.W. Sanborn was involved in making the Sanborn Insurance maps. I think the name is purely a coincidence. The Sanborn Company was founded in New York City in 1867 by Daniel A. Sanborn, a native of Massachusetts. I believe A.W. Sanborn was Albert W. Sanborn, of Ashland, lawyer, land developer, and Wisconsin state senator. As he was born in Vermont in 1853 and moved to Ohio by 1870, it does not seem likely that he would have had any involvement with the Sanborn Company. A copy of his obituary, unfortunately missing the last page, is enclosed.
